### MSU ARC Meeting - October 3rd, 2023

Meeting was called to order by Vice President, Diana Mishica, K4IRU, at 7:04 p.m.

**Roll Call & Question of the Night**: Roll call was done and the question of the night was, "Do you have any family members who are HAM radio operators?"

<u>Program</u>: James Flood, KJ4TKL, presented an interesting and informative program entitled "When All Else Fails."

James went over possible events that may cause chaos and communication systems to fail like: regional and natural disasters, cyber attacks, pandemics, major power grid failures, and war. He explained reasons why it would be wise to stay put in your current home or location.

James explained the advantages and disadvantages of HAM radio in this sort of emergency scenario.

- Some advantages are:
  - Monitoring and talking to local emergency services
  - o Longest range of any portable radio
  - Providing similar services as other radio types
  - o Works well when cell, internet, and other systems are down
  - o Does not rely on a centralized system
  - Source of real time information
- Some disadvantages are:
  - Can be affected by weather
  - Can be affected by terrain
  - o Requires skill and a licensed operator
  - Requires a power source
  - o Requires practice
  - Requires some level of preprograming
  - o Requires knowledge of how to program the radio
  - Requires a list and/or understanding of frequencies

James went over some key things to consider when looking at what kinds of radios, antennas, and power source to use. He also explained when to listen to and operate the radio in an emergency type situation by having it only on for 3 minutes on a rotating schedule usually every 3 hours at midnight, 3am, 6am, 9am, etc. This will save your radio power and your time.

He also discussed the benefit of being able to relay information to and from: shelters, EOCs, medical facilities, emergency services, operational sites, private and neighborhood nets.

<u>Vice President's Report:</u> Diana Mishica, K4IRU, advised that if anyone is interested in presenting a program or has ideas for future programs please see her.

**Secretary's Report:** Bill Call, KJ4W, moved that the September meeting minutes be accepted as submitted. Jana Hackathorn, KN4MWE, seconded the motion. Motion was carried.

<u>System's Report</u>: Bill Call, KJ4W, reported that the only issue this month has been to restart both computers that run the Winlink gateways when MSU sent forced updates to the operating systems. He hasn't finished the repair on the Hamlin repeater amplifier so it is still running at reduced power. Other than that, the 3 Club repeaters, the 2 APRS digipeaters and the two Winlink systems are all working well at the moment as far as he is aware.

<u>VE Report</u>: Bill Call, KJ4W, advised that we had a VE session after the September meeting and Michael Inman, K4MWI, upgraded to General Class. He will try tonight for Extra Class. So far that's the only exam request for tonight.

<u>CERT Report</u>: Bill Call, KJ4W, reported that the Fall 2023 CERT course is underway. We've had 3 sessions so far and have 16 attending; 4 of these are HAM radio operators presently. Several attendees are interested in taking the HAM radio course which will begin on November 9, 2023. CERT members participated in monitoring the weather sirens during the testing we did on September 8, 2023.
